



## **CONTRACT POSITION: Creative Arts & Storytelling Curator**

**Position Title:** Creative Arts & Storytelling Curator

**Project:** Sacred Threads: Weaving Stories, Land, and Safety

**Type:** Contract Position

**Timeline:** Late June to October 30, 2025

**Hours:** Approximately 6 hours per week

**Compensation:** \$1,800 (stipend-based contract)

### **Position Summary:**

The Creative Arts & Storytelling Curator will design and support the artistic and narrative elements of Sacred Threads. This contract role centers storytelling, visual curation, and land-based artistic expression that amplifies marginalized voices. Primarily remote, with in-person presence expected during core events.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Engage and support artists, storytellers, poets, and creative facilitators
- Curate art installations, community reflection spaces, or cultural activities
- Hold narrative space centering land, healing, and ancestral connection
- Amplify BIPOC, Indigenous, queer, disabled, and Two-Spirit creatives

### **Supervision & Collaboration:**

The curator will report to **Kassie Drodge**, Community Organizer with Sierra Club Canada and Co-Founder of the Mixed Coast Collective.

They will also collaborate with members of the Mixed Coast Collective and external partners who share aligned values in creative justice and accessibility.

**Accessibility & Equity Commitment:** We prioritize lived experience and are committed to building a team that reflects the communities we serve. These roles are open to Two-Spirit, Indigiqueer, Black, disabled, trans, migrant, undocumented, and system-impacted folks.
